Chocolate is an eternal favorite, many of us are obsessed. Children and adults alike are passionate about it, inspiring writers, poets and confectioners since the 16th century. The journey of cocoa from distant plantations to chocolate workshops is impressive.

Gathering theoretical and practical experience while making the following products:





We provide an apron and rubber gloves, but you may want to bring an extra t-shirt as well (pretty much everything will be covered in chocolate). Closed shoes are recommended.

In the case of chocolate making more competencies are developed, while we get "artistic" with a very interesting and very popular raw material:

Competence fields:

- cooperation
- process organization (step by step)
- future orientation
- design, construction
- colors, shapes, senses - creating harmony, striving for balance
- mathematical competence: measurement, percentage calculation
- sensitization, attitude formation (if people from different groups work together).

We will have lunch at a restaurant run by our former client based on the plans.

Art Éra Foundation provides low-threshold care for addicts in Budapest, i.e. within the framework of the capital; as well as needle exchange program. In addition, it operates a number of groups, mainly for those involved in criminal proceedings; so-called diversion groups. The interesting thing about the Foundation is that it is physically located right next to a hospital where health care for addicts is provided. On the other hand, in the catchment area of the Keleti Railway Station, where it is known that there is a significant illegal drug trade. Between 2018 and 2021, the Foundation operated a drug prevention program in the community space in the Roma segregation in Kalocsa (CsóKa program) and in a special children's home in Kalocsa (where the offending children are placed).

Dinner together, conversation, ventilation, situation interpretations, analysis.

The next day we visit Vác Strict and Medium Regime Prison.

The penitentiary organization system carries out the penalties, measures, coercive measures imposed by the deprivation of liberty specified in the law, the detentions established during the conversion of fines imposed for violations of the rules, and - within the scope established by law – administrative detention. There are 30 penitentiary institutions and 10 business organizations in Hungary, the number of prisoners is approx. 18000 people (the number of the staff is the half of this number, 9000 persons).

Vác Strict and Medium Regime Prison, which is about 40 kilometers away from Budapest, is a strict institution, i.e. the prison regime is strict and medium. Capacity: 720 people. It's an iconic penitentiary institution in view of the fact that in the 1950s (after 1956) several political prisoners were imprisoned here, and there is also a thematic prison museum to show this (the so-called Doberdó quarters).



Special rules for entering a penitentiary institution:

- since we enter a totally closed institution, by entering we undertake to comply with all strict rules
- entry is a long procedure, please be patient - everyone is scanned in every way (similarly in the case of airports, you have to go through a searchlight gate or prison staff search you for metal objects with a detector, etc.)

- we will not bring a bag, we will leave the mobile phones in the car - we will have only the most necessary things on us (ID card, tissues, etc.)
- if someone needs a special medicine (e.g. for diabetes or asthma), please let us know because we need to let the prison know in advance
- in the case of a metal detection gate and detector inspection, the belts, heavier jewelry, etc. must be taken off if requested (overall, if anything is requested at admission, we must do it within a reasonable range) - a plastic, "prison-compatible" belt is recommended for men
- all stabbing, cutting, shooting devices, etc. have to be left in the car
- no purse for women, so please dress in a way that you can put these things in your pocket
- If you still have to bring something in, we'll have a tote bag to put those in it.

There will NOT be a search, a body cavity examination, etc., we can't be touched by the guards.

On the other hand, we ask everyone to bring your photo passport, the one whose number you sent! So please do not realize at the gate that you left your passport in your hotel room, because then we cannot do anything about it, basically if you don't bring your passport you cannot enter the institution.

Dress code:

- for men, long trousers, T-shirt, shirt, closed shoes
- for women: no exposed shoulders; long skirt or trouser, closed shoes, overall non-provocative clothing.

Inside the institution: we'll go in a group, no one should lag behind or have a separate discourse with a prisoner, etc. Overall, it is not possible to contact a prisoner by yourself.

Bathroom use: within the institute it is quite cumbersome to use the toilet, so we arrange a bathroom use before entering, and you can go inside once, together. It's even harder for women, so if possible, we'll do things like that outside.

Smoking: as we know that Mesut smokes a lot, and we have obviously noticed that he does so in a place that is not designated, "secretly" (here in Hungary it is taken very strictly), and since the penitentiary takes it very strictly, we arranged a smoking "session" we usually don't organize something like this, i.e. you have to endure 2-3-4 hours without nicotine). To avoid this, you will be able to smoke in the designated place once, specifically for the sake of Mesut.

We have a very good professional relationship with this institution, and we have had several art therapy programs here, including when the wall inside the prison was painted by inmates:
